From Hwy. 90 East (Mahan Drive). Take Crump Road, appx. 2 miles North to stop sign at

Miccosukee Rd. Continue on Crump Road and take Left fork at curve onto Roberts Road. Travel 3.3 miles, entrance will be on your right. (5.3 total miles above US 90 East.)

From I-10 coming from East of Tallahassee. Take Exit 31-B, US 90 East toward Monticello. Go East appx. 1 mile. Turn Left onto Crump Road and see above.

From I-10 coming from West of Tallahassee. Take Exit 30, go North 4.8 miles, turn right onto Bradfordville Road. Continue 3.8 miles to stop sign at Centerville Rd. Cross Centerville Rd. & the name changes to Roberts Road. Games entrance is 7/10 miles up Roberts Rd. on the left.

From Capital Circle, NE. Take Centerville Road northeast approximately 6 miles to Roberts Road. Turn Right, entrance is 7/10 miles on your left.
